2011 Kodiak bear hunting news & 2012 forecast

As predicted, we took 10 male Kodiak bears for 10 hunters during 2011.

Seven were large enough for the yearly Boone and Crockett record book entry and one large enough for the all time Boone and Crockett entry.

If the weather cooperates the bears are there and we have a professional staff of guides to help find a giant Kodiak bear.

The bear population and especially the big bear population are at all time highs.

Bear activity is very weather dependent. I only conduct bear hunts that I am confident that the hunter has a very good chance to take a giant bear. Call or e mail for specifics.
